## **EXCAVATION PERMIT – RIGHT OF WAY USAGE FEE EXCEPTIONS**

## The following fees apply to Excavation Permits:

<ul> <li>Application Fee</li> <li>Standard = \$290</li> <li>Secondary = \$95</li> <li>Extension/Revision = \$175</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Right of Way Usage Fees</li> <li>\$9.90 per lane cut, per day</li> <li>\$6.05 per structure cut, per day</li> </ul>
<ul><li>Inspection Fees</li><li>(as determined by DSD)</li></ul>	<ul> <li>ATD Tech Surcharge</li> <li>4% of all fees collected by ATD</li> </ul>

Right of way (ROW) Usage Fees are charged from cut to final restoration. Exceptions are limited to the scenarios outlined below. NOTE: A Right of Way Contractor License is required to perform restoration.

#### **EXCEPTIONS**

## ROW usage fees shall not apply:

- To City of Austin Departments
- To State and Local Franchised Utilities (Franchised Utilities only pay franchise fees)
- When the City of Austin allows restoration to be delayed
  - o NOTE: Delayed restoration is typically allowed when multiple utilities will be installed in the same area
  - NOTE: Once the items outlined below are provided, ROW usage fees will only apply from first cut through trench repair. Trench repair shall satisfy City standards 1100S-2, 1100S-3, 1100S-3A, and/or 1100S-5, as applicable. (i.e. flowable fill and hot patch performed)
  - The following shall be required:
    - Approved paving plan from the <u>Public Works Department</u>, <u>Office of the City Engineer</u>
       acknowledging maintenance and responsibility
    - Written approval from Development Services Department and/or Public Works Department Inspector
    - Written approval from the General Contractor
    - Written approval from subcontractor who will perform restoration, if applicable
    - Approved correction to General Permit, Site Plan, or Site Plan Exemption, if applicable
- To more than one party when two or more parties are simultaneously accessing the same trench
  - o NOTE: The party to perform the first cut will be charged ROW usage fees until restoration
  - Additionally, the following shall be required:
    - Written agreement between parties acknowledging that the party to perform the first cut is responsible for restoration

## When delays occur due to:

- <u>City-implemented work stoppage due to major special events</u>, ROW usage fees will not be assessed while the stoppage is in effect
  - Example: Spring Festival Restrictions, Trail of Lights Restrictions, Austin City Limits Festival
- Unforeseen crises requiring City staff reallocations to non-standard tasks, ROW usage fees will not be assessed
  until staff are returned to standard duty
  - Example: flash flood response, boil water crisis
- Inaccurate City-owned and provided utility records, ROW usage fees will be stopped until the utility redesign receives City approval

- o **NOTE:** Delays due to inaccurate Franchise Utility records, or an unknown/unidentified utility, do not qualify for ROW fee stoppages
- o Written statement from relevant City Official who rendered the inaccurate utility record must be provided
- o The City approval of the utility redesign must be provided
- o This exception does not apply to *incomplete* utility records
