Individual State of Texas Assessment Tool April 22, 2023 Flood Event



The objective of this report is to help state and local emergency management officials determine the level of damages that have occurred during the recent natural disaster. Once the iSTAT is completed, the Texas Division of Emergency Management (TDEM) will work with local officials to validate iSTAT submissions. This helps officials determine the state's eligibility disaster recovery resources including the Small Business Administration (SBA) disaster loan program.

If SBA receives enough eligible reports to declare a disaster, they may provide low-interest loans to qualifying homeowners, renters, and businesses in affected communities through the SBA Disaster Assistance Loans program.
